PROENERGY RECEIVES GOVERNOR'S AWARD

ProEnergy Services received the 2009 Governor's Economic Development Project of the Year award at the Governor's Conference on Economic Development, held recently in St. Louis. The award helps recognize economic development success over the past year, and highlights the company's commitment to strengthening Missouri's economy by creating opportunities and jobs. The Division of Workforce Development has also offered the company job recruitment and referral assistance with a value of \$141,000.
