## ProEnergy Spotlights....

#### GOOSE CREEK ENERGY CENTER SUBMITTED BY KEN NEWTON

Starting Reliability, Year to Date 100% Plant Availability, Year to Date 99.84% (Issues with the gas yard prevented 100%) Gross Output, Year to Date 4263.6 MWh

Calibration's, Calibration's, Calibration's. Annual cal's have been the priority this month...Goose Creek has calibrated 132 instruments so far since March 1<sup>st</sup>, along with closing 122 job requests.

Gas Yard.....working with several vendors to upgrade to fuel gas regulating station as well as a new burner management system for the fuel gas heater.

Goose Creek facility is working with Predict Services to set up a Vibration Analysis Program for all of the pumps and motors throughout the plant that will save money on preventative maintenance costs and help increase overall plant reliability.

The plant has also completed their EMPRV transition to Ameren stock numbers for all spare parts. This has included identifying, labeling and stocking over 325 different part numbers and warehousing them into new bin shelving that Ameren purchased. This will allow anyone who logs into EMPRV able to check inventory and find any parts we have on site.

The facility will also be purchasing a new plant utility vehicle. Ameren has approved a Kawasaki Mule to use around the sight to replace their old Aquila golf cart.
